


Botrytis paeoniae. Botrytis Blight. Di Napier. Private garden. Banbury Street. 14/5/23. (NewToCounty).





Chlorencoelia versiformis. Flea's Ear. Dave Champion. Compton Verney. 24/9/23. (NewToCounty).




